ST. MARIA OF PARIS - OUR NEW PATRON SAINT

St. Maria Skobtsova of Paris, our Outreach patron saint, was born in Latvia in 1891 and like many of the pre-Revolutionary Russian intelligentsia, she was an atheist and a political radical in her youth. She gradually came to accept the truths of the Faith and with a small community of fellow-believers, she established "houses of hospitality" for the poor, the homeless, the alcoholic and mentally ill. As Nazi persecution of Jews in France increased, her work expanded to include protection and care of the most helpless. It is believed that Mother Maria's last act was to take the place of a Jewish woman who was being sent to death in the gas chambers, voluntarily dying in her place. St. Maria was one of the great saints of the last century. May St. Maria intercede for our us.
